Setting: Healing a "Lame Beggar" (Acts 3:8 – 11)

Temple officials arrest Peter and John as they are speaking (4:1-2)

Kind of a "repeat gathering" from a few weeks before

v. 7	By what POWER do you do this?
v. 8-12	Bible answers their question: Filled with the Holy Spirit
v. 13	Perceived as uneducated, common – astonished Recognized they had been with Jesus
v. 18	Charged them to no longer speak or teach in the name of Jesus Options: slink away, acquiesce, stand firm?
v. 19	They stand firm – they don't run away These are not hired hands (John 10) Jesus' words, actions, resurrection are their own – "Rising!" They made HIS their own
