## What God Shows to the World . . .

### 1. The light of the Gospel – His Glory

John 1:1-4 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men.

2 Corinthians 4:6 - For God, who said, “Let light shine out of darkness,” has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

### 2. A light that isn’t “\_\_\_\_\_” by us

God’s glory is about who He is and what He does.  
It is not about who we are and what we’ve done.

2 Cor. 4:2, 5 - But we have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways. We refuse to practice[a] cunning or to tamper with God’s word, but by the open statement of the truth we would commend ourselves to everyone’s conscience in the sight of God. . . For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus’ sake.

2 Corinthians 4:7 - We have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not us.

### 3. A bold light that shines in us to \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus to others - despite our circumstances

2 Corinthians 4:8-11 - We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our bodies. For we who live are always being given over to death for Jesus’ sake, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh.
